

Report on Activities

- ✓ **Re-Orientation Programme** was organised for **UG** final year students on 20th June 2017 at 11.30 a.m. at ESRA Hall to welcome back the students after vacation.
- ✓ **Induction Programme** was organised by the college on 28th June 2017 at 11.00A.M. at ESRA Hall to welcome the UG I semester students and also enable them to get to know the college, interact with the Heads of the Departments & Coordinators of various committees in the college.
- ✓ **World Music Day** was celebrated on 21st June. The celebration began with a PowerPoint presentation on various forms of Music around the world, by Anuradha J. Sreedhar of B.Sc Final year and was followed by a rendition of songs spanning Indian and Western classical music by the Choir group of the College.
- ✓ **Survey on Digital Eye Strain** was conducted on 5th July 2017 by the students of Osmania Medical College on the “Impact of long term usage of digital gadgets on the Eye” at Science Block. Students actively participated in the survey and got awareness about the ill effects of excessive usage of gadgets on eyes. The survey included a proforma which had information about the extent of digital gadgets usage and those students who were identified with dry eyes or sensitive to prolonged usage were tested using strips for checking the level of dryness. The medical students explained the precautions to be taken in such cases.
- ✓ The first **Weekly Assembly** of the academic year 2017-18 was conducted by the students of B.A. II & III years as Eid – special assembly. Verses from Quran signifying secularism were recited. They emphasized on the importance of Ramadan month and explained how the festival of Ramzaan teaches us the importance of charity and togetherness; Shirkhurma (Eid special delicacy) was served to all the staff and students
